Leah Ward Sears retired as Chief Justice of the Georgia Supreme Court in June 2009 after serving on the Supreme Court for 17 years. Justice Sears was the first woman to serve as a Superior Court Judge in Fulton County, Georgia, and was also the first woman and the youngest person ever to sit on the Georgia Supreme Court. Justice Sears is currently a partner at Schiff Hardin, LLP in its Atlanta office where she leads the Appellate Litigation Team and also focuses on policy issues in family law.
