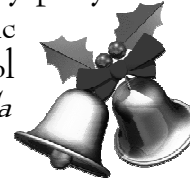
November 8 *Cathedral of Commerce*

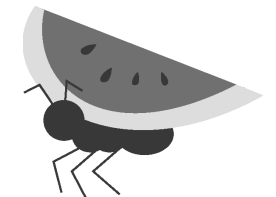
April 10 *The Intersection of Coaching and Ministry*
